in this amazing and expanding universe.

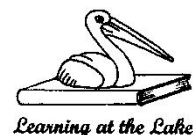
The universe itself keeps on expanding and

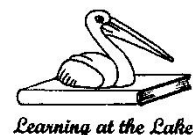
