## FROM THE PRESIDENT:

Like many of you, hopefully reading this column, I have belonged to a number of community and similar organisations over the last 40 or 50 years. While some thrived, others struggled for a few years and then folded. Those that folded had a relatively small membership and only survived while there were a few dedicated members who were willing to stand repeatedly for the management committee. When these willing horses did not stand again for office, replacements could not be found to take their place and the organisations were forced to dissolve. There is a lesson here for us.

Judith and I had our Golden Anniversary in June which, remarkable and joyful as it was, served just again to remind us that time flies and that we are not as spry, fit or mentally alert as we think we used to be.

Our U3A group—can we call it a *chapter* perhaps? - is in its 10th year. Some of the committee members have been serving for all that time and are now in their late 70s or 80s. They deserve to be allowed to rest on their laurels but have continued to serve because replacements cannot be found despite their increasing age and declining health. If replacements cannot be found for these committee members in the next few years then surely experience tells us that the viability of our U3A chapter is in danger.

At the recent celebration of the life of Clive Seale, I got talking to a professional lady, recently retired and in her early 60s I believe. She had worried about what to do once retired but then discovered and joined a sister U3A chapter. What struck me forcefully was the enthusiasm of this comparatively *young* lady for some of the courses offered and for the challenge of helping start up a garden club. She is the type of retiree whom we should try to enlist.

He has a nagging feeling that danger lurks all around him, but doesn't know that he is somehow linked to the death of a wealthy philanthropist who has fallen from the 27th floor.

**22nd Sep CHICAGO:** 2002 (113 min) Renee Zellweger, Catherine Zeta-Jones, Richard Gere, Queen Latifah.
