Richard III ‘The King in the car-park’

5 February, 2013 Reuters International News Agency issued the following news release: “A skeleton found last year during excavation of a medieval friary under a parking lot in the city of Leicester has been confirmed as English King Richard III ....”

This is the fascinating story of how this momentous event happened and also the historical background as to how the body of a King of England was discovered in such an unlikely place.

**WHAT IS U3A?**

The **University of the Third Age** is an international organisation whose aims are the education and stimulation of mainly retired members of the community - those in their third 'age' of life. It is commonly referred to as **U3A**.

One British 'definition' of what "The Third Age" means for U3A participants is -"U3A membership is not related to a specific age but to a period in one’s life (the third age) after the second age of full-time employment and parental responsibility. Anybody in their third age can join U3A and this includes people who are working part-time. There is no lower age for membership."

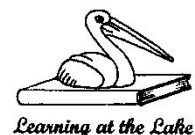
Following its success in Europe, U3A commenced in Melbourne Australia in 1984. From that beginning it has developed into 250 U3As with approximately 85,000 members (as at 2013). These are based in metropolitan, regional and rural areas, and follow the "British" self-help model of teaching and learning over a wide range of subject areas, dependent upon the membership's own expertise, knowledge and skills.

Typical courses include, educationally, Art, Classical Studies, Conversation, Computers, Crafts, Debate, Drama, History, Languages, Literature, Music, Sciences, Social Sciences, Philosophy, etc. Some study groups do not have a prepared syllabus, but draw on reports of current affairs in their topic subject to prompt conversation and research. There are also many less-educational activities - 'Games', including bridge tuition and duplicate bridge playing groups; 'Health, Fitness & Leisure', including countryside walks, Theatre/Concert Clubs, Travel Clubs, Dance in all its forms etc.
